Please find attached our updated Calendar of Events for Term 3. Please note the following:

- There will be a further three Rugby coaching sessions on 19th & 28th May and 20th June.
- We have recently received confirmation that Mark from Skip-n-Rope will be visiting the school on Tuesday 20th May to sell his ropes. Ropes will **ONLY** be available to buy on **Tuesday 20th May**, for the children to use at home. You are under no obligation to buy anything. CHILDREN'S ROPES

- Individual rope costs are as follows...
 - 7ft Speed Rope € 7 (Jun Inf - Sen Inf Children)
 - 8.5 ft Speed Rope € 7 (1st Class - 6th Class Children)
 - 10ft Speed Rope €10 (Adults/Partner Skipping)
 - Family Rope €12 (16ft Long, perfect for 1-3 people in long rope games 1st-6th Class)
 - Double Dutch Set €18 (2 x 16ft Long, perfect for 1-3 people in Double Dutch 1st-6th Class)
 - Long Rope €15 (25ft Long, perfect for 4or more in long rope in 5th & 6th Class only)
- Reminder the school finishes for **ALL PUPILS at 1.40pm on Wednesday 21st May 2025.**
- The School Mass is now on Monday 9th June at 11.30am in Kiltale Church.
- Sports Day - we hope to have it on Friday 20th June (weather permitting).
