- Friendship Week - 3rd - 7th November 2025

 - During the week the children will be involved in a range of activities based upon the themes of friendship, inclusion and respect for difference.
 - We will be holding a **Silly Sock Day** fundraiser on **Friday 7th November** as part of our Amber Flag renewal activities. Children are asked to bring in at least €2 to support this initiative.

Swimming - Pupils from 1st to 6th Class are taking part in 4 weeks of swimming lessons on Tuesdays starting tomorrow 4th November 2025 in Aura, Trim.

- 1st, 3rd and 4th Class will be swimming at 12:15pm.
- 2nd, 5th and 6th Class will be swimming at 1pm
